



## **Dummy** Keypad

KD-100Q

The dummy keypad has flashing LEDs, emits a beep when keys are pressed, and features a professional-looking stainless steel housing—just like a real working keypad.

## **INSTALLATION**

- Remove the faceplate from the base by loosening then removing the two screws on the faceplate.
- 2. The base has battery compartments on both sides. The keypad can operate for 1 (one) year on 2 "AAA" batteries, and 2 (two) years on 4 batteries (AAA, not included).
- 3. Locate the mounting screw holes on the top and bottom edges of the keypad base.
- 4. Using the included screws, mount the keypad on an indoor or outdoor wall next to an entry door where it is clearly visible.
- 5. Replace the metal faceplate but make sure not to over-tighten the screws.
- 6. When the keypad beeps or LED flashes become weak, new batteries are needed.
